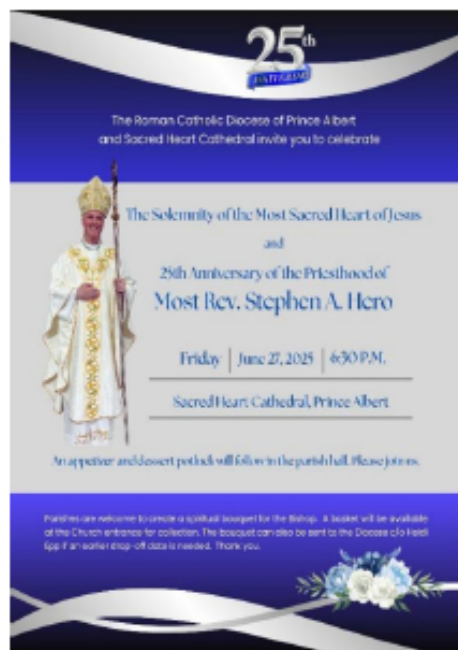


## Sacramental Team

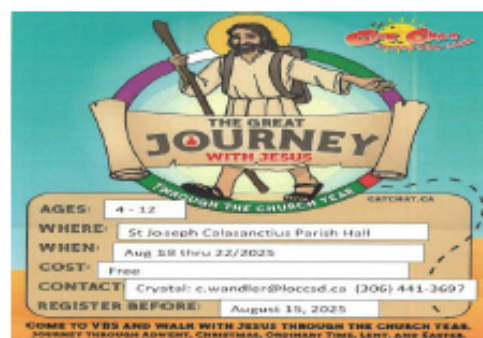


## 25th Anniversary of Priesthood – Bishop Stephen A. Hero
